Antarctica is the coldest place on Earth. The lowest temperature ever recorded there was -89.2°C



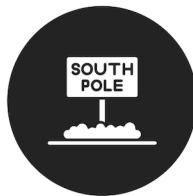
Antarctica has the largest ice sheet on Earth, covering 98% of the continent.



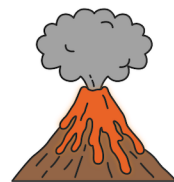
Antarctica is famous for its penguins, including Emperor and Adelie penguins.
