Mauna Loa in Hawaii is the largest volcano on Earth in terms of volume and area covered.



Mount Etna in Sicily, Italy, is one of the world's most active volcanoes, erupting for about 500,000 years.



Volcanic eruptions can cause "dirty thunderstorms," where lightning forms due to static charges from ash and gas.



Iceland, with about 130 volcanoes, is one of the most volcanically active places on Earth.



Olympus Mons on Mars, at 22 kilometers high, is nearly three times the height of Mount Everest.



Volcanic eruptions release gases that can affect the atmosphere and contribute to climate change.



Underwater volcanoes create Earth's longest mountain range, spanning 40,000 miles along midocean ridges.



Obsidian: volcanic glass formed from rapid lava cooling, used for tools and jewelry.
