Whisker Sensitivity

A cat's whiskers are highly sensitive and can detect very small changes in the environment. This helps them navigate in the dark and sense nearby objects.



Super Hearing

Cats can hear frequencies up to 64 kHz, which is more than three times higher than the upper limit of a human's hearing range (20 kHz).



Purring

Cats purr not only when they're content, but also when they're nervous or in pain. Scientists believe purring can have a soothing effect and may even promote healing.



Whiskers

A cat's whiskers are super-sensitive, aiding in navigation, detecting changes, and sizing up tight spaces.



Sleeping
