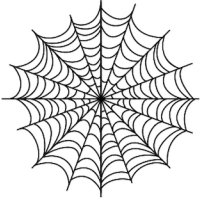
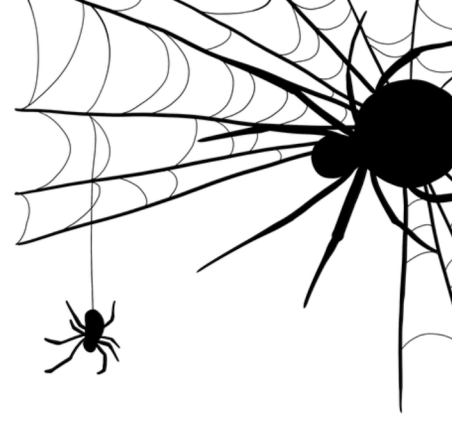


SPIDER FUN FACT FOR KIDS
